

Girls K-3 Everyday Wear

Jumper:

Classic Navy Plaid Jumper purchased from Lands' End (or Land's End vendor)

- Modesty short or legging must be worn underneath jumper when socks are worn (not required with tights). Legging must be solid navy in color and 93% cotton or more, please see www.landsend.com uniform guide for a sample (need not be purchased from Lands' End)



Pants/Shorts with Belt:

Khaki pants (khaki shorts allowed during months of August, September and May only)

- Khaki jeggings, skinny pant, etc. are not permissible
- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' Ends Khaki pants/shorts.
- Black or brown belt required with pants/shorts (belt optional in Kindergarten)



Shirt:

Navy or white peter pan or standard collared short or long sleeve polo (any brand)



Sweater:

Sweater from Lands' End or Schoolbelles is optional on everyday wear but it must have NOCA crest if worn.

Socks:

- Navy, white, tan, or black quarter or crew sock
- Navy or white knee socks
- Navy or white tights

Shoes: Tennis shoes may be worn as part of the daily school uniform for students in grades K-3 only. Tennis shoes are also required for all PE classes. In an effort to promote student safety and preserve the gym floor, adherence to the following school dress code guidelines apply:



- Tennis shoes must be solid black, navy, gray, or white, including logos and soles.
- Clean, lace tied, or Velcro fastened tennis shoes only.
- No zipper, slip-on, or any other fasteners will be allowed.
- No platform, high tops, elevated soles, light up, roller tennis shoes, rhinestone/sparkles, or hiking-style tennis shoes will be allowed.
- Bottoms must be non-marking

Girls K-3 Formal Wear on Wednesdays and as announced

- Plaid jumper from Lands' End
- Sweater cardigan with NOCA crest from Lands' End or Schoolbelles (Sweater on formal day is optional in months of August, September, and May)
- White Peter Pan or standard collared button down dress shirt in long sleeve or short sleeve
 - Cross tie (must be purchased from Lands' End)



Girls 4-5 Everyday Wear

Jumper:

Classic Navy Plaid Jumper purchased from Lands' End (or Land's End vendor)

- Modesty short or legging must be worn underneath jumper when socks are worn (not required with tights). Legging must be solid navy in color and 93% cotton or more, please see www.landsend.com uniform guide for a sample (need not be purchased from Lands' End)



Pants/Shorts with Belt:

Khaki pants (khaki shorts allowed during months of August, September and May only)

- Khaki jeggings, skinny pant, etc. are not permissible
- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' Ends Khaki pants/shorts.
- Black or brown belt required with pants/shorts (belt optional in Kindergarten)



Skirt (5th grade only):

Lands' End Classic Navy Plaid Skirt (three options to choose from) purchased from Lands' End

*Jumpers are preferred for 5th ladies, but skirts may be worn.

Shirt:

Navy or white peter pan or standard collared short or long sleeve polo (any brand)



Sweater:

Sweater from Lands' End or Schoolbelles is optional on everyday wear but it must have NOCA crest if worn.



Socks:

- Navy, white, tan, or black quarter or crew sock
- Navy or white knee socks
- Navy or white tights

Shoes:

Navy, brown, or black shoes (athletic shoes are **not** allowed, but should be brought to change into on PE days).

- All footwear must be closed-toe with a closed heel no more than 1" high.
- Shoes must not rise more than 1" above the ankle.
- Winter, rain, cowboy/riding, and hiking boots are not allowed in the classroom.
- Winter and rain boots may be brought to school for recess and other outdoor activities during the school day.

Girls 4-5 Formal Wear on Wednesdays and as announced

- Plaid jumper from Lands' End
- Sweater cardigan with NOCA crest from Lands' End or Schoolbelles (Sweater on formal day is optional in months of August, September, and May)
- White Peter Pan or standard collared button down dress shirt in long sleeve or short sleeve
 - Cross tie (must be purchased from Lands' End)



Girls 6th-8th Everyday Wear

Skirt:

Lands' End Classic Navy Plaid Skirt (three options to choose from) purchased from Lands' End

- Modesty short or leggings must be worn underneath skirt when socks are worn (not required with tights). Legging must be solid navy in color and 93% cotton or more, please see www.landsend.com uniform guide for a sample (need not be purchased from Lands' End)

Pants/Shorts with Belt:

Khaki pant

(Khaki shorts allowed during months of August, September and May only)

- Khaki jeggings, skinny pant, etc. are not permissible
- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' End Khaki pants/shorts
- Black or brown belt required with pants/shorts

Shirt:

Navy or white collared short or long sleeve polo shirt (any brand)

Socks:

- Navy, white, tan, or black quarter or crew sock
- Navy or white knee socks
- Navy or white tights allowed

Shoes:

Navy, brown, or black shoes (athletic shoes are **not** allowed).

- All footwear must be closed-toe with a closed heel no more than 1" high.
- Shoes must not rise more than 1" above the ankle.
- Winter, rain, cowboy/riding, and hiking boots are not allowed in the classroom.
- Winter and rain boots may be brought to school for recess and other outdoor activities during the school day.

Sweater:

Pullover Sweater

Zip up Sweater

*Sweater from Lands' End or Schoolbelles is optional on everyday wear but it must have NOCA crest if worn.



Girls 6th – 8th Formal Wear on Wednesdays and as announced

- Classic Navy Plaid Skirt from Lands' End
- Pullover sweater with NOCA crest from Lands' End or Schoolbelles (Sweater on formal day is optional in months of August, September, and May)
- White collared button down dress shirt in long sleeve or short sleeve
 - Cross tie (must be purchased from Lands' End)
- See everyday wear for sock/shoe requirements.



High School (9-12 Grade) Girls

Skirt:

Lands' End Classic Navy Plaid Skirt (three options to choose from) purchased from Lands' End

- Modesty short or leggings must be worn underneath skirt when socks are worn (not required with tights). Legging must be solid navy in color and 93% cotton or more, please see www.landsend.com uniform guide for a sample (need not be purchased from Lands' End)



Shirt:

Light blue long sleeve dress shirt



Blazer:

Solid Navy Blazer from Lands' End or Schoolbelles or another vendor (such as Gap, French Toast, and Old Navy, to name a few) that carries a similar uniform line in the style indicated.

- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' End's and Schoolbelles Navy Blazer.



Tie:

Solid Navy Cross Tie from Lands' End or Schoolbelles



Socks:

- Navy, white, tan or black quarter or crew sock
- Navy or white knee socks
- Navy or white tights allowed

Shoes:

Navy, brown, or black shoes (athletic shoes are **not** allowed).

- All footwear must be closed-toe with a closed heel no more than 1" high.
- Shoes must not rise more than 1" above the ankle.
- Winter, rain, cowboy/riding, and hiking boots are not allowed in the classroom.

NOTE: In the months of August, September, and May students will have a relaxed dress code which allows white or navy polos to be worn with skirt in lieu of the dress shirt. Blazer is optional.

Girls 7th- 12th Grade

Shirt:

Lands' End or Schoolbelles grey t-shirt with heat transfer NOCA crest



Shorts:

Lands' End navy mesh shorts

Boys K-3 Everyday Wear

Pants/Shorts:

Khaki pants

Khaki shorts (during months of August, September and May only)

Black or brown belt (belt optional in Kindergarten)

Shirt:

Navy or white short or long sleeve polo (any brand)

- Brand name may not be visible



Sweater (optional):

Cardigan/Vest

- Optional for everyday wear, but must have the NOCA crest if worn
- Must be purchased from Lands' End or Schoolbelles

Socks:

White, Black, Tan, or Navy Quarter or Crew Socks



Shoes: Tennis shoes may be worn as part of the daily school uniform for students in grades K-3 only. Tennis shoes are also required for all PE classes. In an effort to promote student safety and preserve the gym floor, adherence to the following school dress code guidelines apply:

- Tennis shoes must be solid black, navy, gray, or white, including logos and soles.
- Clean, lace tied, or Velcro fastened tennis shoes only.
- No zipper, slip-on, or any other fasteners will be allowed.
- No platform, high tops, elevated soles, light up, roller tennis shoes, rhinestone/sparkles, or hiking-style tennis shoes will be allowed.
- Bottoms must be non-marking.

Boys 4-5 Everyday Wear

Pants/Shorts:

Khaki pants

Khaki shorts (during months of August, September and May only)

- Style and color must be comparable to Lands Ends' khaki pants/shorts



Belt:

Black or brown belt (belt optional in Kindergarten)

Shirt:

Navy or white short or long sleeve polo (any brand)

- Brand name may not be visible

Boys 6th-8th Everyday Wear

Pants/Shorts:

Khaki pants

(Khaki shorts allowed during months of August, September and May only)

- No khaki jeggings, skinny pant, etc.
- Style and color must be comparable to Lands Ends' khaki pants/shorts



Belt:

Black or brown belt

Shirt:

Navy or white short or long sleeve polo (any brand)

- Brand name may not be visible



Sweater (optional):

Sweater/Pullover

- Optional for everyday wear, but must have the NOCA crest if worn
- Must be purchased from Lands' End or Schoolbelles



Socks:

White, black, tan, or navy quarter or crew socks

Shoes:

Navy, tan, brown, or black dress shoes (athletic shoes are **not** allowed).

- All footwear must be closed-toe with a closed heel no more than 1" high.
- Shoes must not rise more than 1" above the ankle.
- Winter, rain, cowboy/riding, and hiking boots are not allowed in the classroom.
- Winter and rain boots may be brought to school for recess and other outdoor activities during the school day.

Boys 6-8 Formal Wear on Wednesdays and as announced

- White button down dress shirt in long or short sleeve
- Sweater with NOCA crest from Lands' End or Schoolbelles
- Tie in Classic Navy Plaid (must be purchased from Lands' End)



- Everyday shoe requirement
- Everyday belt requirement
- Everyday socks requirement
- Khaki Pant

High School (9-12th Grade) Boys

Shirt:

Light blue long sleeve button down uniform dress shirt

- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' End or Schoolbelles, but may be any brand

Blazer:

Solid navy blazer with or without NOCA crest

- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' End or Schoolbelles, but may be any brand

Belt:

Solid black or brown belt

Socks:

White, tan, black, or navy quarter or crew socks

Tie:

Solid navy or

Navy/red stripe purchased from Lands' End or Schoolbelles

Pants:

Khaki pants

- No khaki jeggings, skinny pant, etc.
- Style and color must be comparable to Lands' End or Schoolbelles

Shoes:

Dress shoes in navy, brown, or black (athletic shoes **not** permitted)

- All footwear must be closed-toe with a closed heel no more than 1" high.
- Shoes must not rise more than 1" above the ankle.
- Winter, rain, cowboy/riding, and hiking boots are not allowed in the classroom

NOTE: In the months of August, September, and May students will have a relaxed dress code which allows a white or navy polo to be worn in lieu of the dress shirt with dress slacks or shorts. Blazer is optional in those months.

**The following are questions to ask before purchasing an item or leaving home in the morning.
You should be able to answer "no" to all of the following questions:**

For appearance:

- Is my hair messy, ungroomed, distracting, or a color other than natural blonde (not bleached), brown, black, or natural red?
- Do I have any tattoos or body art showing?
- Is my makeup unnatural-looking, dark, or distracting?
- Are my accessories distracting or outside the spirit of the uniform policy?

If the answer to any of the above questions is "yes," students should tidy or change their appearance before arriving at school.

For sweaters:

- Is this sweater something other than a crew, v-neck, zip-up, or cardigan style (depending on grade)?
- Is this sweater a color other than navy?
- Is this sweater baggy or too small for the student?
- Does this sweater fall below the waist?
- Am I missing a dress shirt underneath this sweater?

If the answer to any of the above questions is "yes," the sweater is not allowed indoors.

For polos:

- Is the polo untucked from pants or skirt?

If the answer to the above questions is "yes," the polo should be tucked in.

For skirts and jumpers:

- Is this skirt or jumper more than 2" above the knee? (Even if it was the right length earlier in the year!)

If the answer to the above question is "yes," the skirt or dress is not allowed at school.

For chinos:

- Are these pants in a color other than khaki?
- Are these made of hiking/water wicking material or athletic material?
- Do these pants have cargo pockets?
- Are these pants made of stretchy material?
- Do these pants fit skin-tight or show undergarments?

If the answer to any of the above questions is "yes," the chinos are not allowed at school.

Footwear quick guide:

- Is the dominant color of the shoe something other than Navy, Tan, Brown, or Black?
- Is there any color on the shoe other than Navy, Tan, Brown, or Black?
- Do the shoes have a pattern or graphic on them?
- Do the shoes have an open heel or toe?
- Do the shoes rise more than one inch above the ankle?
- Do the shoes have a heel taller than one inch?
- Do the shoes contain fur, yarn, or other slipper-like materials?
- Is the shoe a sneaker?

If the answer to any of the above questions is "yes," the shoes are not allowed indoors.
